- Gift cards in \$25, \$50 and \$100 amounts to stores like Target, Fred Meyer, Safeway, Walmart
- Gift cards in \$10, \$25, and \$50 to gas stations
- Gift cards in \$10 and \$25 amounts to restaurants like McDonalds, Subway and Taco Bell
- Gift cards in \$25 and \$50 amounts to stores like TJMaxx, Marshall's, Sally Beauty and Ross
- Used cell phones and tablets
- Phone charger cables and bricks
- Bath mats, shower curtains and shower curtain rings
- Bath towel sets
- Twin and full-size blankets
- Twin and full-size sheets
- Standard-sized pillows
- New, plain adult t-shirts, sweatpants, leggings, and sweatshirts (sz XS-6X)
- Children's t-shirts, sweatpants and sweatshirts (all sizes)
- Children's underwear
- Adult underwear, boxers and bras
- Reusable totes, backpacks and duffel bags
- Hair care products for coarse, curly and kinky hair (Brand examples: Devacurl, Shea Moisture, Carol's Daughter, Alaffia, Cantu)

## Other items that help survivors at SafePlace:

- Toilet paper and paper towels
- Trash bags and Ziploc bags
- Can openers
- Children's hygiene products (baby shampoo, body wash, kid-size toothbrushes and toothpaste)

**What we are unable to accept at this time:** • Clothing items unless otherwise listed • Used clothing, blankets, stuffed animals, or other fabric items • Children's items (clothes, cribs, feeding items) • Used or opened hygiene items or food Furniture • Used toys that are unable to be wiped down or sanitized • Books • Appliances • Suitcases • TVs and other electronics • Queen, King, and very bulky blankets or sheets • crochet and knitted blankets • lap blankets/quilts
